

What Our Office Has Done to Provide a Safe and Healthy Reopening

- As clean as our office always is, we have thoroughly sanitized all surface and areas
- Entry through the office doorways will be hands-free
- The reception room will be empty of patients, with the following exceptions:
 - The parent of a minor child
 - An adult caregiver for a patient requiring assistance
- Plexiglass barriers have been installed between the reception room and the front desk
- Door enclosures have been installed at the entrances to all treatment rooms
- Industrial strength air purifiers with HEPA filters have been installed in each treatment room
- Additional training has been implemented for our Dental Team members to help insure safety for all
- Additional PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) including special masks, disposable gowns, head-coverings and face shields will be worn by Dental Team members
- New sanitizing procedures and products will be used in our treatment rooms before and after each patient is seen
- Additional appointment time and revised scheduling will allow for greater attention to patient treatment as well as additional cleaning of all areas. This will require patience as it is time-consuming and may reduce our daily patient scheduling capacity
- Hand sanitizer stations are now located throughout the office
- Temperatures will be taken when each Dental Team Member enters the office each day
- It is essential that you **DOWNLOAD** the **PATIENT MEDICAL SCREENING QUESTIONNAIRE** and complete it prior to entering the office, as previously described.
